

## Jesus is God; He is Not Created; He is not Only a Man

**Jesus is God.** To believe otherwise is to call Him a liar. It is not simply a theological disagreement when one claims Jesus is *not* God. To teach falsely about the Godhead is blasphemy.

The One and only Living God is the God of the Bible. He is True God in **three persons with distinct personalities.**\* God, the Father is spirit who has *revealed* Himself in His world and in His Word. God the Son is *incarnate*; He is the God-Man born in the flesh.\*\* God, the Son walked the earth; died physically; was physically resurrected; physically ascended to the right of God, the Father; and will physically return to earth at the appointed hour. God, the Spirit *operates in spirit* and cannot be seen. Any born again person's spirit is sealed and indwelt by God's Holy Spirit. All three Persons —the Father —the Son —and the Holy Spirit —are equally God and cooperate as the One God they are.

\*How is it that God possess "personality?" He is intelligent (omniscient); He is sentient (possessing of thinking consciousness); and He is a living being. No member of the Triune Godhead lacks personality.

\*\* Solomon Mandelkorn in his 1896 *Veteris Testamenti Concordantiae Hebraicae atque Chaldaicae* translates *alma* in Isa 7:14. He states that *puella nubilis* is a marriageable child, while *virgo matura* is mature virgin (881).
