

Oy Vey! Even Gentiles included in God's Plan?

“The Jewish idea is that the Torah of Moses is a truth for all humanity, whether Jewish or not. The Torah (as explained in the Talmud - Sanhedrin 58b) presents seven mitzvot for non-Jews to observe. These **seven laws are the pillars of human civilization**, and are named the "Seven Laws of Noah," since all humans are descended from Noah. They are:

Do not murder.

Do not steal.

Do not worship false gods.

Do not be sexually immoral.

Do not eat a limb removed from a live animal.

Do not curse God.

Set up courts and bring offenders to justice.

Maimonides explains that any human being who faithfully observes these laws earns a proper place in heaven. So you see, the Torah is for all humanity, no conversion necessary.” [**‘earns’ is in error!**]

[**The theological error of this Noahic position is the flip side of the error of Dual Covenant theology. Neither does the Lord institute one covenant for Jews (Law of Moses) but another covenant for Gentiles (New Covenant) —nor does He require Gentiles to come under a previously failed covenant made with Noah. It is one new man (both Jew and Gentile) that reconciles all men to God (Ephesians 2:15). The entire world has lived for 2,000 years under the blessings of the New Covenant God made with the Jew in this dispensation of His saving grace —with the full benefits of that Covenant not fully in effect until Jews surviving Jacob’s Trouble finally cry out to Messiah “Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord” (Psa 118:26; Matt 21:9, 23:39; Mark 11:9; Luke 13:35, 19:38; and John 12:13). “The covenant will be *realized* in the *millennial age*” (J. D. Pentecost). In this age Jews and Gentiles come under one inclusive covenant, the “eternal covenant” (Isa 24:5, 61:8; Jer 32:40, 50:5; and Heb 13:20).
